

Planning your journey

Westminster College has very limited on-site car and motorbike parking and, from **Thursday 1st February 2018**, Westminster College carpark will be regulated as below:

- Monday to Friday – 8am to 5pm – Annual Permit holders only
- Monday to Friday – 5pm to 8am – Pay and Display (£1.50 per hour, £5.00 over 3 hours and overnight stay)
- Weekends All day – Pay and Display (£1.50 per hour, £5.00 over 3 hours and overnight stay)

Although the College is easily accessible from the major road networks (A14 and M11), parking on-site remains **extremely limited** and we cannot guarantee parking on-site on arrival. Also Cambridge gets very **congested during peak times** and access by car might not be the fastest mean of transport. Therefore, when possible, we strongly encourage using public transports and/or alternatively parking around the College, like Madingley Road Park and Ride, Pound Hill parking or Castle Hill pay and display. Whilst planning your journey there are a number of alternatives we encourage you to consider. Distances quoted are via taxi / on foot;

Other Options and Alternatives

Bicycles

You can secure your bicycle to the railing on the building in the East Wing. We also have a secure bike store, accessible via Pound Hill. Please contact Reception on 01223 33 06 30 for further details.

Arriving by Train - CB1 2JW – 1.75 miles

Cambridge Train Station is 2.2 miles away from Westminster College. If you're travelling from London, the Kings Cross Express takes around 50 minutes and runs every half hour, week days.

From the train station to Westminster takes approximately 30 minutes to walk. Buses run regularly from the station to Drummer Street in the City Centre, which is then about a 20 minute walk to the College. Taxis from the train station are readily available and cost approximately £10.

Arriving by Bus – CB1 1JF – 1.1 miles

The Drummer Street bus station (CB1 1NQ - regional busses) and Parkside bus station (CB1 1JF - national busses) are both around a 20 minute walk from Westminster.

Alternative Car Parks (prices correct at time of press)

Pound Hill – Short Stay / Free Overnight – CB3 0AE – around the corner

On-street, metered car parking, payable using cash at the machine or by using RingGo on mobile phones. It is regularly patrolled. Charges at the time of printing:

- Monday to Saturday: free to 9am, free after 5pm, no restrictions.
From 9am to 5pm, 2 hour maximum stay at 50p per 30 minutes.
- Sunday: free before 9am, free after 5pm, no restrictions.
From 9am to 5pm, 4 hour maximum stay at 50p per 30 minutes.
- Suitable for overnight between 5pm and 9am, free of charge

Castle Hill – Long Stay / Closed Overnight – CB3 0AR – 0.2 miles

Off-street, metered parking, payable by cash or cards at the machine or by using RingGo on mobile phones. Charges at the time of printing:

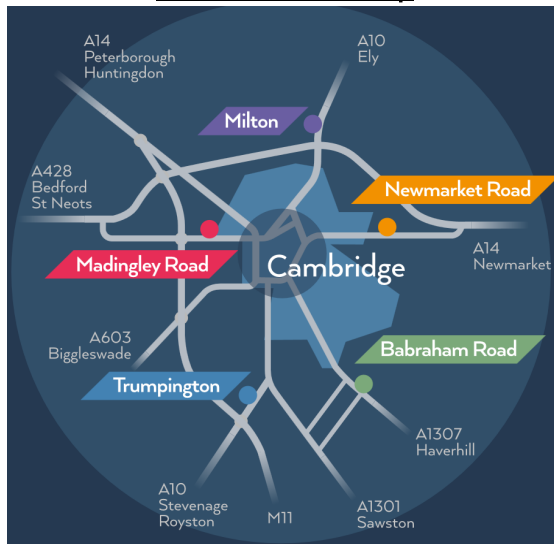
- Monday to Friday: free before 8am, free after 7pm. Between 8am and 7pm, Up to 2 hours is £2.50, up to 4 hours is £4.80, over 4 hours is £8.
- Saturday: free before 9am, free after 7pm. Between 9am and 7pm, Up to 2 hours is £2.50, up to 4 hours is £4.80, over 4 hours is £8.
- Sunday: free before 10am, free after 5pm. Between 10am and 5pm, charge is £4 all day regardless of stay.
- Not suitable for overnight

Park and Ride – Long Stay / Charge for Overnight

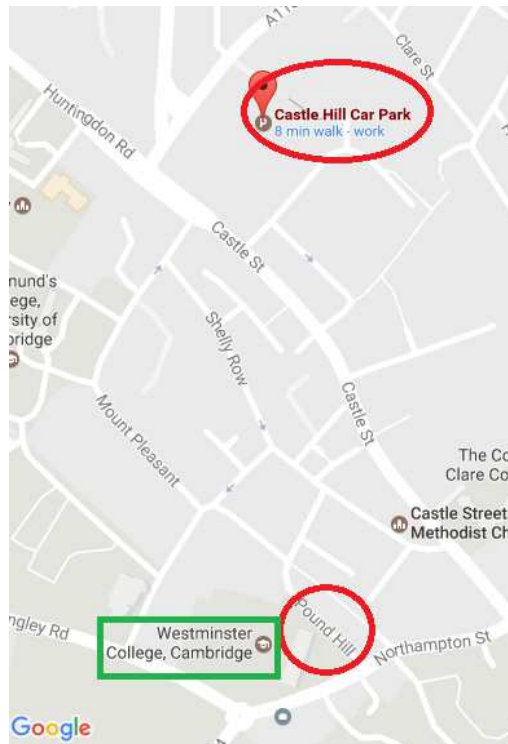
There are five dedicated, out of town, park and ride options and for each one you'll pay;

- Up to 18 hours per day: £1 or all week for £5, payable on site by cash or card or by RingGo on mobiles.
- Up to 72 hours (includes overnight): 18 to 24 hours £10, 24 to 48 hours £20, 48 to 72 hours £30, payable on site by cash or card or by RingGo on mobile phones
- Additional fee of £3 day return to use the bus, payable on site by cash or card, or from the bus driver
- Suitable for overnight, see note about 18 hours + as above.
- **From the North:** Milton Park and Ride – CB24 6DQ – 3.7 miles (Junction 33, A14 / A10)
- **From the East:** Newmarket Road Park and Ride – CB5 8AA – 3.9 miles (Junction 35, A14 / A1303)
- **From the South East:** Babraham Park and Ride – CB22 3AB – 3.9 miles (A11 / A1307)
- **From the South West:** Trumpington Park and Ride – CB2 9FT – 3.6 miles (Junction 11, M11 / A1134)
- **From the West:** Madingley Road Park and Ride – CB3 0EX – 1.4 miles (Junction 13, M11 / A1303)
