

COVID-Secure Site measures

We are so looking forward to welcoming you to Westminster College and we will be doing all we can to make your stay as enjoyable and safe as possible. To help with this as the College emerges out of lockdown we will put measures in place for the benefit of our guests, visitors, students and staff. These are explained below.

-72 hours to arrival	Please stay at home if:
	 Persistent cough Temperature of over 38 degrees Loss of taste or smell
	 Quarantine-related to recent international travel Awaiting coronavirus test results Have been contacted by NHS Test and Trace and required to isolate
-48 hours	COVID-Secure measures:
	 Rapid lateral flow test is strongly encouraged although not mandatory Contact our team if you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms Our Team will be on hand to answer any queries ahead of the trip
On arrival	Follow signage and one-way system:
	 Temperature-check, for temperatures above 38 degrees, we will carry out a second check alongside other COVID-19 symptoms to ensure it is safe to enter premises We strongly encourage every customer and visitor to scan the NHS QR code using their NHS COVID-19 app, or provide their name and contact details, not just a lead member of the group
During	While you are staying with us:
	 Continue to be diligent about washing your hands thoroughly and frequently. Handwashing facilities are provided in the toilets and hand sanitiser stations are located throughout the building Face masks or coverings are strongly encouraged in all public and shared spaces, apart from when eating or drinking, or if you are medically exempt Aim to keep a 2m distance from others although this can reduce to 1m+ if you are both wearing masks

	 Fit your own lapel mic if you are presenting as part of a conference or event Our team will be on hand to assist you from a socially distanced position
Finally	If you feel unwell at any time during your stay:
	 Please let your conference organiser or Reception know immediately We will ask whether you have symptoms of Covid-19 We may ask to take your temperature
After	If you feel unwell within 72 hours after your stay
	 Please get advice from NHS 111 or a GP Update your NHS Test and Trace app Let your conference organiser or us know as soon as possible
